Season Pass Types and Usage Times

- Unlimited passes are valid anytime. Off-peak passes are valid anytime Mon-Fri and after 4pm on Weekends, Holidays and resort holidays.
- Season passes are not valid for snowtubing.
- In the event that a guest forgets their pass, Guest Services will issue one complimentary "forgotten pass" ticket. In the event that the guest forgets their pass again, they will need to purchase a \$25 replacement pass to access the slopes.
- Season passes must be presented to lift attendants before boarding chairlifts.
- Season Passes are non-transferable and may not be shared with other guests.

Pass holders who disregard these usage policies will be charged with Theft of Services by the Pennsylvania State Police.

Season Pass Re-Imbursement

Bear Creek Mountain Resort and Conference Center's Season Pass refund policy, effective at time of purchase due to illness or injury:

Season Passes Picked Up:

Opening Day to 12/31/11 – 50% credit toward next years pass

1/1/12 to 1/31/12 – 25% credit toward next years pass

2/1/12 to End of season – No credit

Season Passes not Picked Up:

Passes that have not been picked up from Guest Services can be rolled over to the following season without fee or penalty, regardless of rate increase. In this circumstance, pass holder must contact Guest Services by April 1, 2012 to roll over the season pass.
